We were given the opportunity to deliver the food bags to families in the area. It was awesome to see how much joy we were able to bring to people by making such a small gesture. We were also given the opportunity to play with some of the kids who lived at the orphanage on the ranch.

Once again, thank you for your support. I hope that I will have the opportunity to go back to Honduras again soon,
