G.R.O.W. in 2009**Godliness - Relationships - Outreach - Wisdom****Would God Choose You?**

In Acts 1:21-26, Peter points out to the other eleven apostles that it is necessary to replace Judas. Thus, the apostles nominate two men to be considered for this position - Barsabbas and Matthias. Both of these men were a disciple of Jesus from the time he was baptized by John. Both of these men were present during Jesus' ministry. Both of these men witnessed the ascension of Jesus. Both of these men were qualified. The apostles turned the decision over to the Lord, and they prayed "You, Lord, who know the hearts of all men, show which one of these two You have chosen to occupy this ministry and apostleship from which Judas turned aside to go to his own place." The decision was left to God because he knows the heart of every person. After examining their hearts, one man was chosen by God and the other was not.

Imagine that you were one of these nominees. Your name was placed before God as a candidate for this position, and God examined your heart. Would you have been chosen? Remember when Samuel was sent to the home of Jesse to select the next king of Israel in 1 Samuel 16. Samuel expects the eldest son of Jesse to be selected as the next king because he looked the part. However, God told Samuel, "Do not look at his appearance or at the height of his stature, because I have rejected him; for God sees not as man sees, for man looks at the outward appearance, but the LORD looks at the heart" (1 Samuel 16:7 NASB). The Lord is examining our hearts. He knows what is inside of us even if the world around us is fooled. What does the Lord see inside you today?
