Kelvin Teamer is youth minister at the Church of Christ at Bouldercrest in Atlanta, Georgia. He has faithfully served as such from August 2000 to the present. His mission and focus has been to serve the

Lord by educating and empowering youth to live the types of lives that will serve the Kingdom both now and in the future.

Kelvin, a native of Illinois, is a graduate of Southern Illinois University and The Georgia School of Preaching and Biblical Studies. He is currently pursuing his Master of Divinity degree, with a specialization in Marriage and Family Therapy from Amridge University.

He has helped to establish the Youth Xplosion, which is a youth-based conference that is held annually. He has also designed Biblical Institute training programs for elementary, middle and high school students within his congregation. He works three days a week at Cross Keys Counseling Center where he is a Marriage and Family Therapy Intern.

Kelvin is married to the love of his life wife, Kim. They have one son, Joshua Thomas. they reside in Ellenwood, Georgia.
