**"Crucifixion Numbers"**

7. There are seven statements made by Jesus while hanging on the cross:

- "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing" (Luke 23:34).
- "I tell you the truth, today you will be with me in paradise" (Luke 23:43).
- "Here is your son" and "Here is your mother" (John 19:26-27).
- "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?" (Matthew 27:46).
- "I am thirsty" (John 19:28)
- "It is finished" (John 19:30)
- "Father, into your hands I commit my spirit" (Luke 23:46).

6. Jesus hung upon the cross for six hours (Mark 15:25, 33). For the first three hours there was light, but during the last three hours, darkness filled the land.

5. Five wounds were inflicted upon Jesus: his head which was pierced by the crown of thorns, his back which was shredded by the flogging, his hands which were driven through with nails as were his feet, and his side which was pierced by a spear. Remember the words of Peter, "by his wounds you have been healed" (1 Peter 2:24).

4. There were four soldiers gambling for Jesus' garments (John 19:23-25). These soldiers were too preoccupied with their desires to recognize who they were crucifying.

3. Three crosses were placed on Golgotha that day (John 19:17-18).

2. Two criminals were crucified with Jesus - one on his right and one on his left (Luke 23:33). These two criminals argued as one ridiculed Jesus and the other defended him (Luke 23:39-43).

1. One man died for our sins. One man was the Son of God. Thus, only one man can be called our Savior (Mark 15:39).
