God said: "My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge" (Hos. 4:6). 2 Pet. 3:18 adds to this understanding: "but grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ." How would a Christian who wishes to grow in the knowledge of God's revealed Word do so by only attending services on Sunday morning?

Hebrews 10:25 is more direct: "not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together; as is the manner of some, but exhorting *one another*, and so much the more as you see the day approaching." James 4:17 adds to this thought: "Therefore, to him who knows to do well and does not do it, to him it is sin." Certainly attending the services of the church is doing well, especially for the Christian that desires to be pleasing to God.
