"Who I AM"

In Exodus 3, God tells Moses that He wants him to return to Egypt and bring his children out of slavery. However, Moses is reluctant. Why? If you remember Moses' past you'll remember that he was raised in the house of Pharaoh, he killed an Egyptian whom he saw beating a Hebrew slave, and he's been gone for 40 years. Now, God wants him to return as a former member of Pharaoh's family, as a fugitive from the law, and as someone who abandoned his own people for decades.

In Exodus 3:11 Moses responds to God's directions saying, "**Who am I**, that I should go to Pharaoh and bring the Israelites out of Egypt?" God responds, "I will be with you." But Moses continues to make excuses in 3:13, "Suppose I go to the Israelites and say to them, 'The God of your fathers has sent me to you,' and they ask me, 'What is his name?' Then what shall I tell them?" But God has a response for this as well. He says, "**I am who I am**. This is what you are to say to the Israelites: 'I AM has sent me to you.'"

When God provided His name to Moses I think He also made a profound point. He ultimately told Moses, "It doesn't matter who you are; it only matters who 'I AM.'" It didn't matter that Moses grew up in the house of Pharaoh, that Moses killed an Egyptian, nor that Moses had been gone for 40 years because it didn't matter who Moses was, it only matters who God is. Likewise, it doesn't matter who you are - what your social status is, what your economic forecast looks like, where you work, how much education you have, which political party you select, what happened in your past - it only matters who 'I AM.'"
