"A Period, A Question Mark, or an Exclamation Point"

If the disciples were asked to describe Resurrection Sunday only using punctuation marks, which punctuation mark do you think they would choose to use?

At first they would probably use a period. Jesus was dead. He was buried. For the past three years they placed their faith in someone who was no longer. Their expectations of a new kingdom were destroyed. Now they feared for their own lives. The day began as a period.

But then comes news of an empty tomb. The stone is rolled away, the linens are lying inside, and Jesus is nowhere to be found. Questions arise. Where is He? Did someone take Him? What happened? The period changes into a question mark.

Finally, an angel questions the women who came to the tomb. "Why do you seek the living among the dead?" he asks. From that point forward Jesus appears to his disciples on numerous occasions. All of a sudden everything He taught them makes sense. The question mark becomes an exclamation point!

Now ask yourself how you would describe the resurrection using only punctuation marks.

Is it a period - something that happened in the past but does not matter today? Is it a question mark - something that leaves you confused? Is it an exclamation point - something on which you base your faith?

"if Christ is not risen, your faith is futile..." (1 Corinthians 15:7), "But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ" (1 Corinthians 15:57)!
