**"Live by Faith, Not By Fear"**

During his years as premier of the Soviet Union, Nikita Khrushchev denounced many of the policies and atrocities of Joseph Stalin. Once, as he censured Stalin in a public meeting, Khrushchev was interrupted by a shout from a heckler in the audience. "You were one of Stalin's colleagues. Why didn't you stop him?" "Who said that?" roared Khrushchev. An agonizing silence followed as nobody in the room dared move a muscle. Then Khrushchev replied quietly, "Now you know why."

Fear can be crippling. It can prevent us from reaching our full potential, it can prevent us from fulfilling our responsibilities, and it can prevent us from taking a stand for the truth. Fear crippled the apostles during the time between Jesus' arrest and His ascension. Every one of the apostles deserted Jesus in some fashion during his arrest and trial. Following his death they even locked the doors when they met together for fear of the Jews (John 20:19). It wasn't until after the Ascension that faith overcame fear in their lives so that they boldly proclaimed the gospel message throughout the book of Acts (Acts 5:41). Dr. E. Stanley Jones once wrote, "I am inwardly fashioned for faith, not fear. Fear is not my native land; faith is." May we live by faith and not by fear so that Jesus will be exalted through our lives.

## Our Bible Study Classes

I want to commend Bible class teachers for the great job you are doing and especially those teaching children. Teaching others is a very important responsibility in grounding our children, young people, and adults in the faith to help them to go to heaven. The eternal destinies of many souls are involved. We are only one generation away from apostasy. If we don't teach our children the truth of God's word while they are under our guidance, they will apostatize and be lost. This is very serious.

God wants His word to be taught diligently. We read in Deuteronomy 6:6-7, "And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart. In 2 Timothy 3:15 Paul told Timothy, "From childhood you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation." Timothy was taught as a child but what happens when God's word is not studied and taught? God says in Hosea 4:6, "My people are destroyed for a lack of knowledge." If we fail to study and teach God's word both our children and we will be destroyed for a lack of knowledge.

Why do people fall away? Hebrews 3:12 says, "Beware brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief in departing from the living God." How do we build our faith so we will not have "an evil heart of unbelief in departing from the living God"? Romans 10:17 says, "So then faith comes by hearing and hearing by the word of God." And as James 1:21 says, "Receive with meekness the implanted word, which is able to save your souls." Only by knowing God's word can our children and our souls be saved so we can go to heaven. Besides our study at home, let's take full advantage of our Bible study classes at church.
