"Be a Barnabas"

Barnabas was known for being an encourager (Acts 4:36). He had the uncanny ability to see the best in others despite their shortfalls. It was Barnabas who vouched for Paul when all of the other disciples were still afraid of him (Acts 9:26-17). It was Barnabas who continued using John Mark as a missionary partner even after the latter deserted him and Paul on the first missionary journey shortly after it began (Acts 13:13; 15:37-40). Whatever Barnabas saw in John Mark came to fruition as Paul eventually requested Mark's presence with him in Rome because, as Paul said, "he is useful to me in ministry" (2 Timothy 4:11).

May we strive like Barnabas to be people who can not only forgive others for their mistakes but also discover the potential within them.
