"Train a Timothy"

Timothy was Paul's "beloved and faithful son in the Lord" (1 Corinthians 4:17). Timothy was unique because of his youth (1 Timothy 4:12), frequent illness (1 Timothy 5:23), and what appears to be a timid spirit (2 Timothy 1:7). These obstacles may have proven to be too much to overcome for Timothy had it not been for the continual guidance and encouragement from Paul. When Timothy's age became a hurdle, Paul encouraged him not to let anyone despise or look down on his youthfulness. When Timothy's illness became a hurdle, Paul provided instructions on how to alleviate some of his problems. When Timothy's fear or timidity became a hurdle, Paul reminded him of the spiritual gifts and blessings that God gave Him.

Paul trained Timothy so that the latter would be successful in his ministry. Paul devoted his time and his wisdom to a young man that would carry the torch long after he was gone. We, too, should seek to train Timothy's. As mature Christians we should find young men and women with whom we can share our time, our wisdom, our talents, and our words of encouragement. In fact, Paul via Titus gives instructions for older men to set the standard of behavior, for the younger men to follow their example, and for older women to teach the younger women how they ought to live (Titus 2:1-8).

Paul recognized that Timothy needed to be trained in order to become the Christian leader that the church needed. Our young people need the training of mature Christian men and women in order to prepare them to lead the next generation of the church. Find a Timothy, train a Timothy, and thereby leave a legacy.
