The Fruits of Our Labor

Last week we conducted a door knocking campaign and gospel meeting with the assistance of the Roebuck Parkway Church of Christ out of Birmingham, AL and the Kensington Woods Church of Christ out of Hattiesburg, MS. This week we enthusiastically share with you the success of this campaign.

Over a 4 day period, we were able to pass out over 7500 newsletters to the community of Pensacola. We covered an area stretching as far north as Kingsfield Rd, as far south as I-10, as far west as Pensacola Blvd, and as far east as Davis Hwy, with a few outlying areas covered as well. Although the newsletters emphasized our Gospel Meeting, they also provided our service times, contact information, and ministries offered.

In addition to passing out thousands of newsletters, we were able to sign up over 285 individuals to receive a free Bible correspondence course that the Roebuck Parkway congregation will administer. We also welcomed at least two visitors to our Gospel Meeting each night who attended as a direct result of the door knocking campaign, and, at present, some of these individuals are continuing to visit our congregation. Most importantly, a young man from the Kensington Woods congregation decided to become a child of God because of his experience with this campaign. We rejoice with the angels in heaven at his decision.

Sometimes it is difficult to see the fruits of our labor but as we reflect on the events of last week we can already see fruit growing, and we eagerly anticipate what is yet to come (1 Corinthians 3:7-8).
