"Beware of Curare"

In 1799 the famous Prussian explorer and scientist Baron Von Humboldt discovered a potent drug called curare on an expedition into the jungles of Venezuela. Curare is a paralyzing potion derived from jungle plants in South America and it possesses 2 curious properties. Humboldt witnessed the first property when he watched a native hunter bring down a large animal with a single shot from his bow and arrow. The arrow had been poisoned with curare, which, when injected into the bloodstream, is deadly. It prevents muscles from contracting which ultimately leads to asphyxiation as the respiratory muscles are affected. Humboldt witnessed the second property when he became sick and a native medicine man forced him to drink an unknown liquid. The drink consisted of curare diluted with water, which, when ingested orally, is a soothing muscle relaxant. The same substance was used both to kill and to heal, but the key to its impact was based on the way in which it was absorbed into the body.

In the same way, the impact of Christianity depends on the way in which it is received. Many choose to take it orally, diluted as much as possible, so that it has few side effects and makes them feel better - but this is not the purpose of true Christianity. Christianity's purpose is to change us into new creations in Christ (2 Corinthians 5:17; Ephesians 4:22-24). In order for us to become new creations, we must die to our old selves and be born again (Romans 6:3-4). Don't settle for watered-down Christianity but instead be crucified with Christ so that He lives in you (Galatians 2:20).
